AIM OF THE PRE APPRENTICESHIP WEEK

MCMT has developed a week-long course, which will give students an insight into our technical academies and the apprenticeship routes available. The programme has been developed to enable students to fully explore and gain invaluable hands on experience of potential apprenticeship progression routes.

During the week students will be involved in a programme of workshops which will be delivered both online and face to face.

All work carried out is funded by the European Social Fund, targeted at students aged 15 and above who live in Shropshire and Telford and Wrekin.

GATSBY BENCHMARKS

The pre apprenticeship week will support you in addressing the following Gatsby benchmarks:

- 1. A stable careers programme** - Each part of the course is linked to a range of career sectors within engineering.
- 2. Learning from labour market information** - Each part is linked to a local SME, students will get to meet a range of local employers and apprentices both virtually and face to face.
- 3. Addressing the needs of every pupil** - The materials have been developed to be delivered using a range of formats to make accessible for all to support in raising aspirations for all.
- 4. Linking curriculum learning to careers** - Each part is linked to an industry sector and reflects the Science, D&T and Engineering Curriculum.
- 5. Encounters with employers and employees** - Students will have the opportunity to meet employers from each sector both virtually and face to face.
- 7. Encounters with further or higher education** - Offers meaningful encounters and experiences with apprenticeship providers remotely.
- 8. Personal Guidance** - All students will receive guidance and support on the application process for apprenticeship training routes and will receive an interview.
